- ❖ Since 2010, annual examination for first year B.A., B.Com., B.Sc. and B.Sc. (Biotech.) is conducted by the college and 80-20 pattern is followed as per the University guidelines.

### Monitoring system

The Principal along with IQAC and in-charge of all faculties monitor the conduct of faculty in classes and during practical and keep a record of classes missed by the teachers. The concern teachers are asked to conduct the missed lectures.

The IQAC conducts midterm meetings to review the progress in teaching learning and to work out a solution to help out low performing students.

### Evaluation system

- Student feedback committee collects feedback from students on (punctuality, teaching ability) course, library, sports, office, hostel. This committee analyses and evaluates the performance for the same.
- The IQAC, based on the student feedback, gives suggestions to concerned teachers.
- After declaration of examination results, the examination department analyses class wise results and the information is provided to Principal of the college.
- The IQAC provides the members of faculty with a letter of appreciation or of improvement based upon the performance of students under the guidance of faculty.

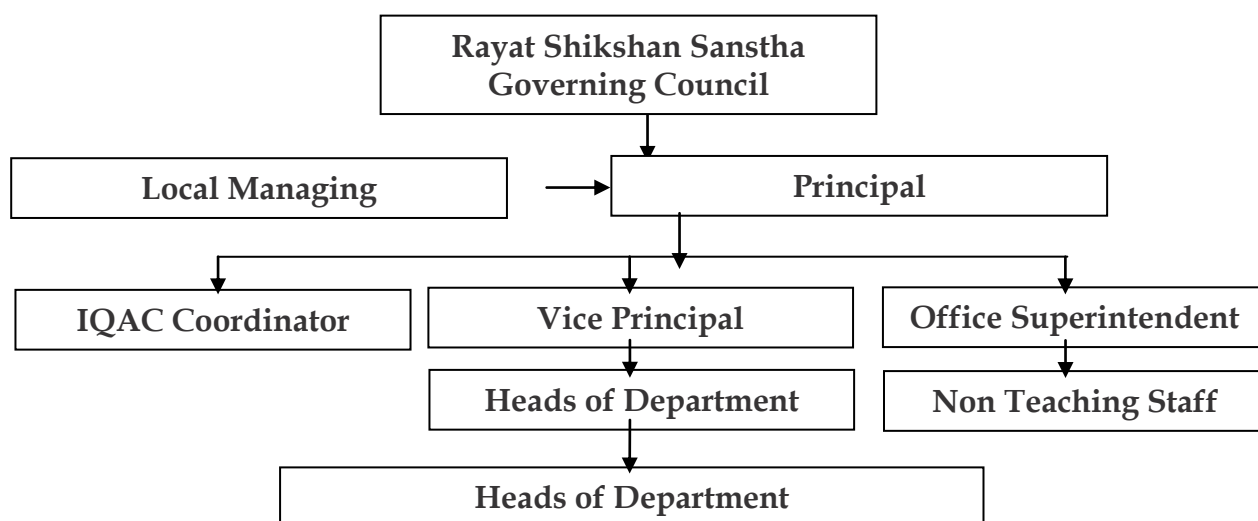

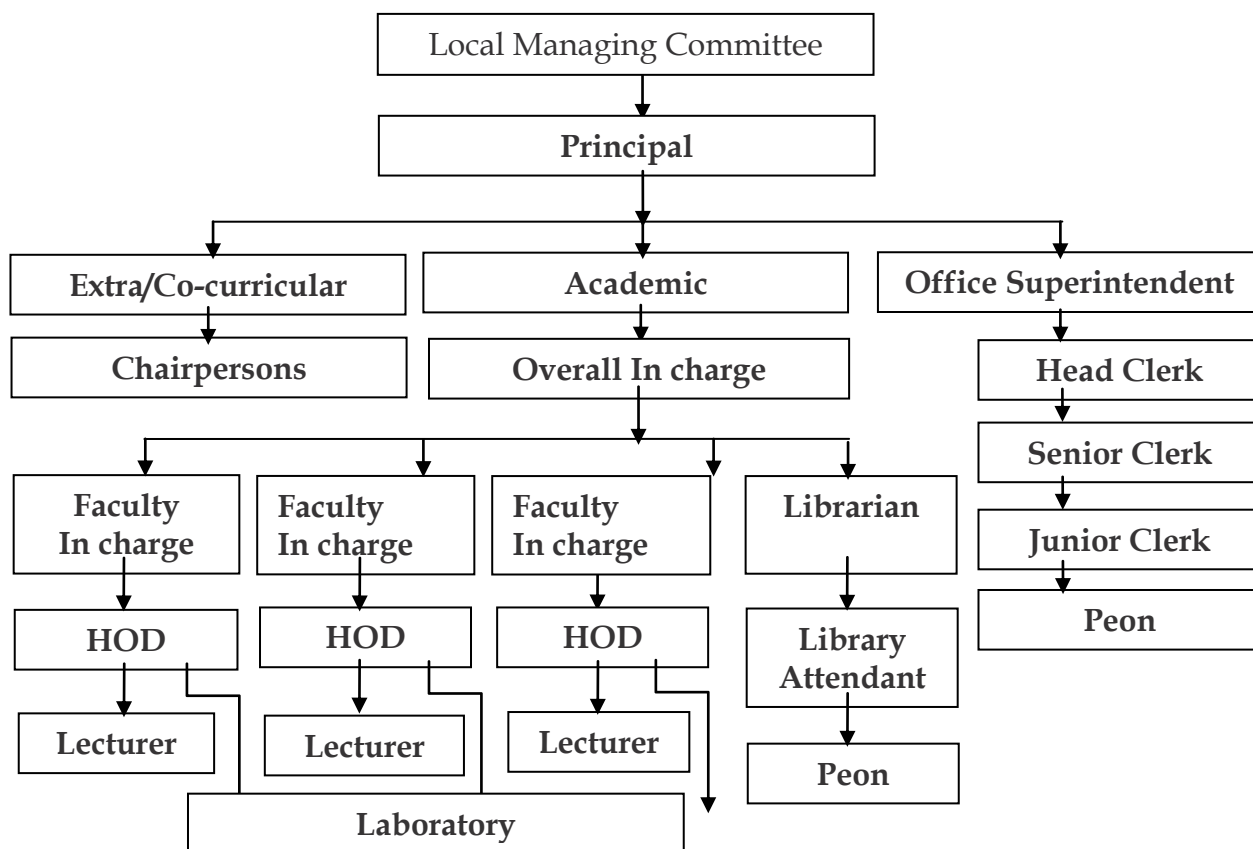
