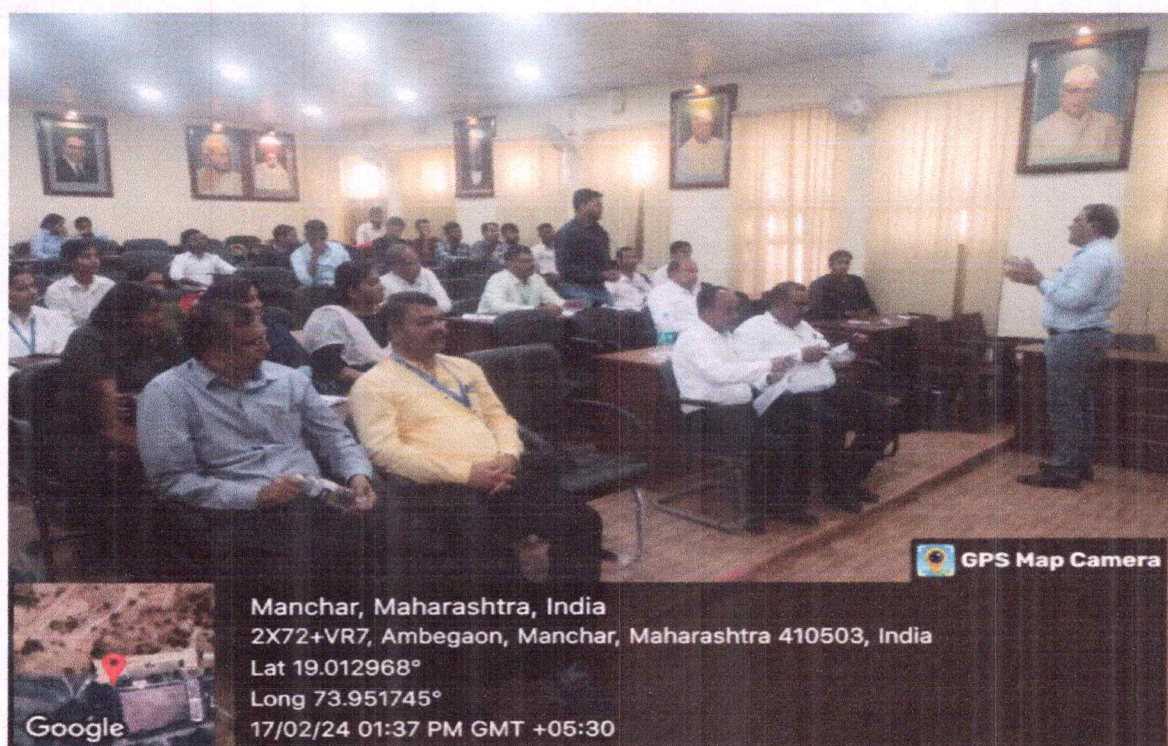

During the workshop, several key insights were shared by the speakers


- **Understanding Agency Priorities:** It is crucial for applicants to thoroughly understand the priorities and focus areas of each funding agency to align their proposals effectively.

- **Peer Review Process:** Understanding the peer review process and incorporating feedback from reviewers play a significant role in improving the quality of grant proposals.


Conclusion:

Training Methodology: Demonstration and Question & Answer

Brief Report:

Based on the guidelines from the affiliating university, the college examination committee had organized the teachers training programme inviting all teachers to participate in the training programme. However, considering the ongoing theory and practical examinations only 35 teachers were able to participate. The facilitator highlighted the changes introduced by the affiliating university in its portal for online internal marks submission. He emphasized the need and importance for these changes and their benefits for the teachers. To enhance the teachers understanding of the new changes the facilitator demonstrated the procedure of batch creating, assignment of internal examiner, downloading the Excel sheet for marks entry, marks entry procedure, uploading the relevant file to the appropriate tab, preview of the submitted file, removal of the incorrect file, resubmission of new file, confirmation of marks by examiner, confirmation of marks by HoD & Principal.

Teachers were encouraged to ask their queries, which were resolved through discussion and demonstration. The user manual was shared with all teaching faculties through WhatsApp group.

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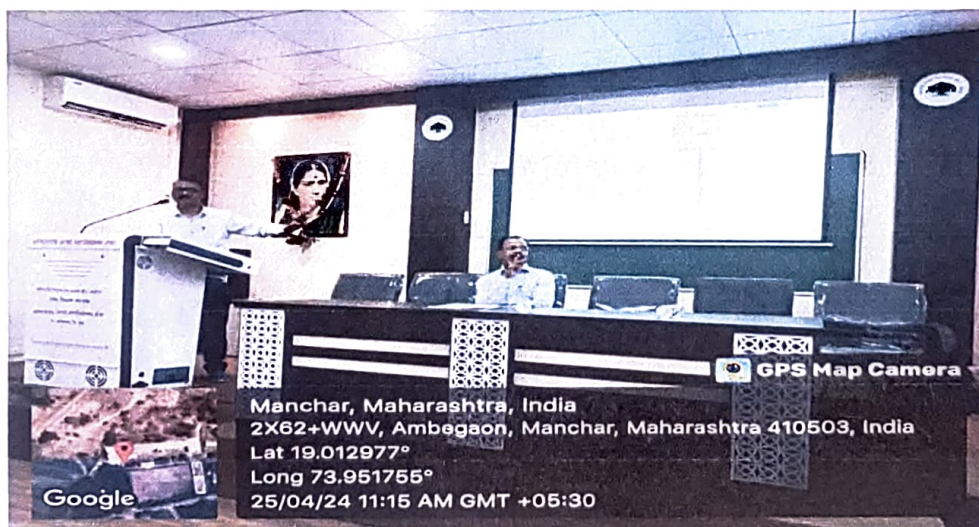
